HIS DEPTH OF WICKEDNESS

- He made aggressive departures (33:1-10).
- The departure was the same as, but worse than the world (33:2, 9).
- The people went along with him (33:10).



HIS REPENTANCE

- The chastisement is sent (33:11; cf. Heb. 12:5-11).
- We see the unlikeliest repentance (33:12).
- God hears and accepts the repentance (33:13).



THE RESULT

- His repentance was genuine and bore fruits (33:15-16).
- But he could not completely undo the damage (33:17).
