A GLIMPSE OF GLORY

- The scene we open with is fantastic (Ezek. 1; 10:15).
- We see this glory again a little later (8:1-4).
- This glory is then seen in comparison to the idolatry of the nation (8:5-18).
- We look at God to see who He is (6:13; 7:9; 37:14, 28; 18:23).

GO TELL THEM

- We do not have the privilege to merely sit and stare at the glory of the Lord (2:1-2).
- He commands to say “Thus says the Lord God” (2:4; 3:11).
- We are not preaching to a receptive audience (2:3-7).
- We ought to love the message even if it is full of sorrow (2:8-3:3).
- We must have great resolve as the world becomes less likely to listen (3:8-9).
- God holds us accountable for what we know and what we say (3:17-21).
- We need to give more of God’s message and less of our own (3:26-27).
