OBSERVATIONS

- Pay careful attention to God's words (40:4).
- The measurements mean more to someone who is invested.
- Walls=separation. Gates=access (40:5-10).
- As God describes the Temple, the greatest feature is His presence (43:1-9).
- He is reminded of departure of the glory (11:23).
- The Temple plan would make the people ashamed (43:10-13; 6:9; 20:43).
- No one treads where God treads (44:1-3).
- This Temple would have laws and ordinances (44:4-6).
- This is illustrated by the circumcision (44:9; Jn. 14:31).
- The priests would teach the difference in the holy and the profane (44:23).
- Their inheritance is the Lord (44:28).
- A life-giving stream would flow from the Temple (47:1-12).
- The scene ends with the name "Yahweh shammah" (48:35).
