



# FAITH IN JOSHUA

Hebrews 11:30-31

# THE FAITH OF THE PEOPLE

- They begin by showing great zeal (1:16-18).
- Circumcision at this time and place took considerable faith (5:7-8; Gen. 34:24-27).
- Think of the faith involved at Jericho (6:3, 10-11).
- They showed faith in rooting out sin (7:25-26).
- They were faithful in managing conflict (22).
- At the end of conquest they echo their faith from the beginning (24:15-22).
- They show faith in fulfilling Joseph's request (24:32).

# THE FAITH OF THE GENTILES

- Rahab expresses an absolute belief in God (2:9-13).
- She is willing to do whatever is asked of her (2:21).
- The Gibeonites believe in who God is and what His people will do (9:9-10, 24).
- They are humble in accepting whatever conditions are placed on them (9:25).

# THE FAITH OF CALEB AND JOSHUA

- Caleb shows great and enduring faith (14:6-14).
- Joshua is faithful in all that God has asked of him (1:8; 11:15).
- In his faithfulness, Joshua points forward to our conquering savior (10:24-25; cf. Heb. 10:13; Rom. 8:37).
