

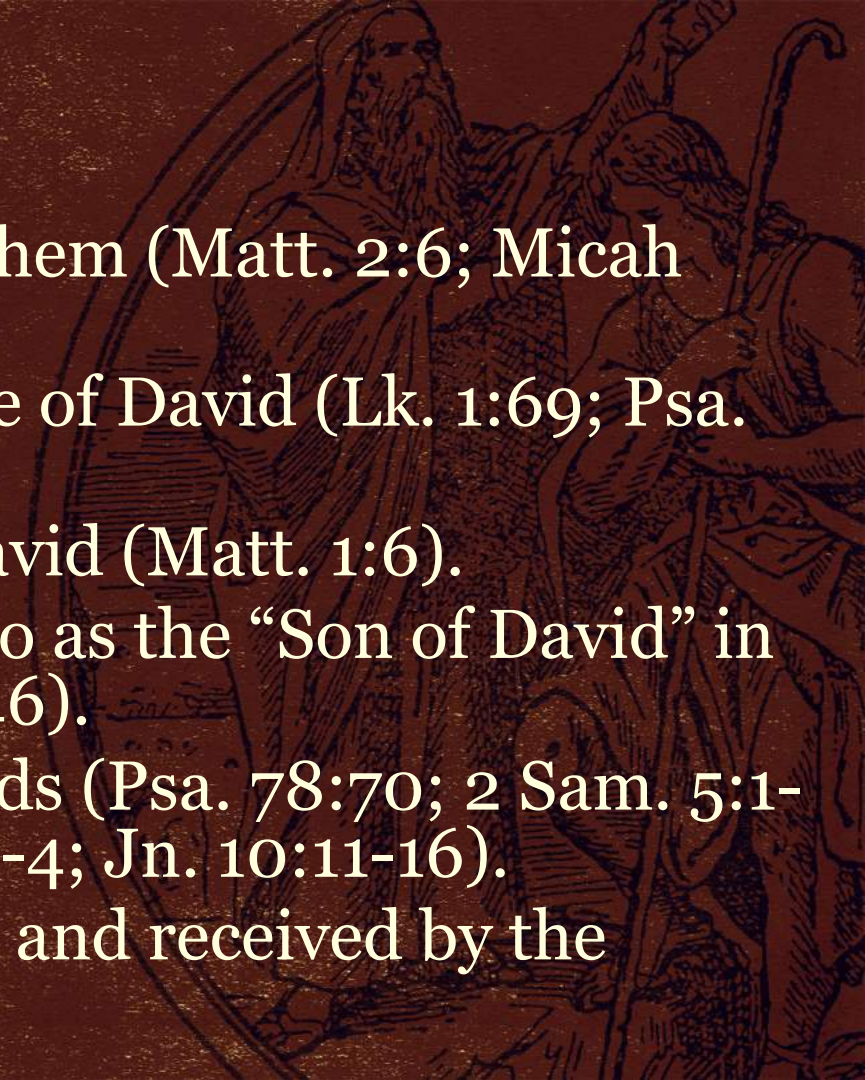
*David, the

Major Connections

- They are both born in Bethlehem (Matt. 2:6; Micah 5:2).
- Jesus is the horn of the house of David (Lk. 1:69; Psa. 132:17).
- Jesus is king in the line of David (Matt. 1:6).
- Jesus is repeatedly referred to as the “Son of David” in Matthew (9:27; 21:9; 22:41-46).
- David and Jesus are shepherds (Psa. 78:70; 2 Sam. 5:1-2; Ezek. 34:23-24; Micah 5:2-4; Jn. 10:11-16).
- David is rejected by the Jews and received by the Gentiles.



Shadows in David's Life

- A king from the sons of Jesse (1 Sam. 16:1).
- David is anointed (1 Sam. 16:2-13).
- David defeats Goliath (1 Sam. 17:4, 8, 25-26).
- He draws the weak and makes them mighty men (1 Sam. 22:1-2).
- David is afflicted (2 Sam. 15:25-26, 30; 16:8-13).
- He intercedes for the people at a Ornan's threshing floor (2 Sam. 24; 2 Chron. 3:1).
- David makes provision for his perfect son to build the temple of God (1 Chron 29:19).
