WHAT GOD IS TO YOU

- David starts with a plea for preservation (v. 1).
- He is my refuge (v. 1).
- He is my Lord (v. 2).
- He is all of my good (v. 2).
- He is all I hope to gain (v. 5).
- He is my counselor (v. 7).

THE FOUNDATIONS OF CONFIDENCE

- David starts with a plea (v. 1).
- He progresses with statements of reliance v. 2-7).
- He follows up with confidence that God will deliver (v. 8).
- Then notice the depth of that confidence (v. 9-11).
- All of this without knowing exactly how it would be accomplished (Acts 2:25-31).
