# The Layout

- The book starts out with a long list of genealogies (ch. 1-9).
- David ascends to the throne (ch. 10-12).
- The Ark is moved to Jerusalem (ch. 13-16).
- The reign of king David (ch. 17-21).
- The preparation and organization of the temple (ch. 22-29).





# The Timing

- The genealogies give us a time marker (3:19).
- Both 1 and 2 Chronicles were historically combined as a single unit.
- The last words of 2 Chronicles match the first words of Ezra exactly.



# The Point

- The genealogies are reminding the people of important history.
- The focus is on David because the promise is still alive.
- The instructions for the temple are given in considerable detail because the people are returning to set things back in order.





# Some Lessons

- God always records facts for a purpose.
- God is in charge and has not forgotten His promises (5:25; 6:15; 10:13-14; 11:9; 14:17; 17:8; 18:6, 13).
- God is at the center of it all (13:6; 22:1; 16:8-12; 17:16-24; 29:10-13).
