Micah 7:7-9

JUDGMENT AND HOPE

- The message of Micah, like many prophets, is filled with the just wrath of God (1:6; 4:10).
- But it is also a message filled with hope (7:18-19).
- In fact, it is a repeating progression (1:2-2:11; 2:12-13; 3:1-12; 4:1-5:15; 6:1-7:7; 7:8-20).
- The hope takes shape in the form of the Messiah (5:2-5).



MICAH THE SINNER

- Micah 5 is not the only place that Jesus appears in this prophecy (7:5-6; Matt. 7:6).
- In response to this division, Micah communicates his confidence in his Savior (7:7-8).
- But this is not haughty confidence (7:9).
- This is the humble confidence of all who would preach the truth (3:8).
- This is not confidence in any sort of cheap grace (6:8).
- This is the only honest way to lead others to Him (1 Tim. 1:13-15).
