2. By whose power (or authority) did Peter heal this lame man? How quickly did the healing take effect? How did this (formerly) lame man respond?
3. Did the people recognize this (formerly) lame man? How did they respond?
4. In his speech to the crowd, whom did Peter credit with the power to heal the lame man?

5. What did God do for Jesus? In contrast, how did these people treat Him? What concession did Peter grant for the part they played?
6. What had God foretold, and by whom had He foretold it?
7. What did Peter tell the people to do, and what would happen if they did?
8. How long had God been foretelling of the coming of the Christ?
9. What notable prophet and prophecy did Peter cite, and where in the Old Testament is this prophecy found?

10. What had Samuel and prophets following him all foretold?

11. Which of God's promises to Abraham did Peter cite?

12. According to Peter, who fulfilled this promise and the prophecies he had cited?

13. Thought Question: Why did Peter choose to heal the man he did instead of someone else?
