3. How did the attitude and behavior of the Jews in Berea differ from most in Thessalonica? Consequently, how did they respond to Paul's message?

4. When the Jews in Thessalonica heard what Paul was doing in Berea, what did they do? What did Paul therefore have to do?

5. What so vexed Paul as he looked about Athens?

6. How does the Holy Spirit characterize the occupation of the Athenians and the foreigners in their midst?

7. What differences do we find between Saul's speech to the Athenians and the sermons we have seen up to this point in Acts? What similarities?

8. What had God overlooked in ages past, and what, in contrast, had He begun recently to command? Why had God begun to command something different?

10. What three reactions did Paul receive from the members of his audience?
