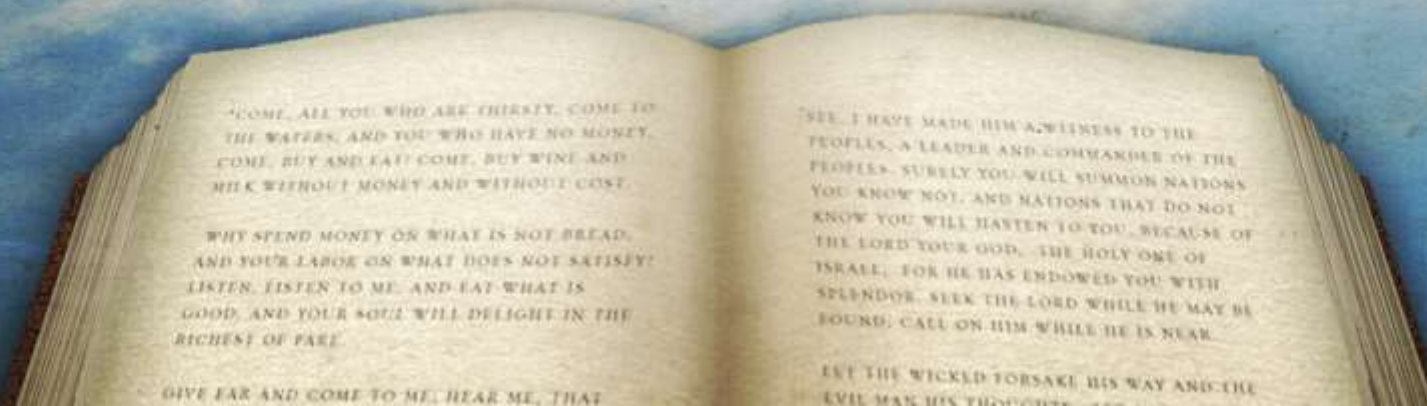


# THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ISAIAH

FOUND; CALL ON HIM WHILE HE IS NEAR.

# GOD'S PLAN

- Without God we are lost (1:9).
- He is coming here (7:14).
- He will send someone to prepare the way (40:3).
- More will stumble over Him than receive Him (8:14).
- He will rise up from Galilee (9:1-2).
- He will be from the seed of Jesse and will rule the world (9:6-7; 11:10).
- Death itself will be among His conquered foes (25:8).





# THE SERVANT

- He will conquer through obedience service (42:1).
- It will look nothing like other conquerers (42:3).
- He will be killed for us (53:8).
- He will submit willingly and silently (53:7).
- He will carry the weight of the world (53:4).





# OUR RESPONSE

- Come let us reason together (1:18).
- Preaching is God's plan to reach us (6:9-10).
- He pleads with us to hear (42:18).
- Trust is a key theme in this book (26:4).
- We couple that with repentance (30:15).
- We will call on His name and confess it before men (12:4).
- We even have the imagery of washing away the filth (1:16; 4:4).
