Psalm 45:13-15



A DIFFERENT KIND OF WOMAN

- “The fact that I am a woman does not make me a different kind of Christian, but the fact that I am a Christian does make me a different kind of woman,”
- We want wise women but not sassy ones (1 Sam. 25; Matt. 10:16; 1 Kgs. 21).
- We want beautiful ladies but not vain ones (1 Pet. 3:3-6).
- We want strong women, but not masculine ones (Prov. 31:17, 25; 1 Pet. 3:7).
- Consider the nature of heroines of scripture (Judges 4:17-21).



RAISING PILLARS

- We need to be thoughtful about the image we are pursuing (Psa. 144:12).
- In that image we see the roles of strength, integrity, and beauty.
- Pillars have a supporting role (1 Tim. 3:15).
- Pillars also give us a picture of connectivity (Prov. 31:10-31).



DADDY'S GIRL

- A father's love is a firm foundation for daughters (1 Jn. 4:16-18).
- Be a tender rock (Jn. 11:23-35; Jas. 1:19).
- Be her protector and guide (1 Cor. 7:36-38; 1 Tim. 2:9).
