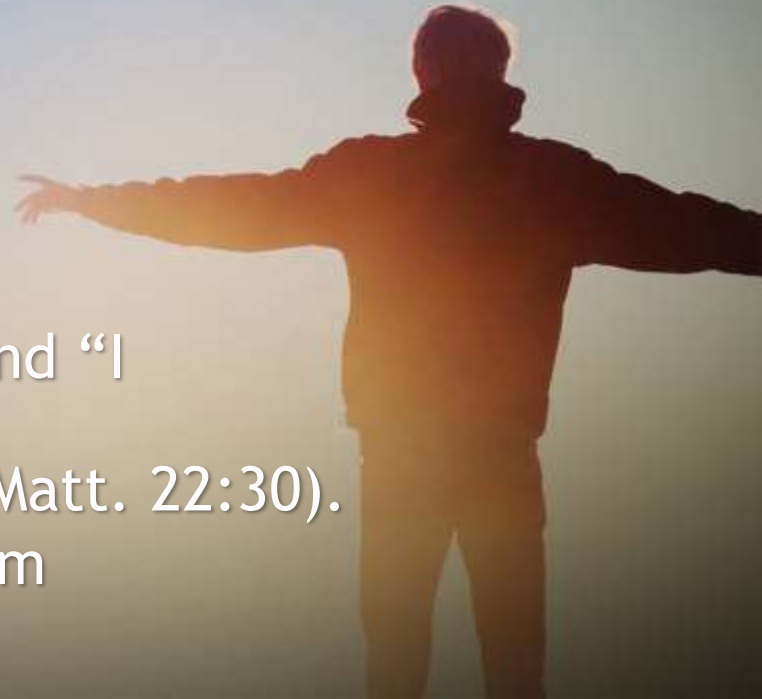
To The Contented
