

How to Get and Conduct Bible Studies

Colossians 4:2–6

- Never underestimate the value of personal preparation inside and outside of the assemblies – 1 Tim 4:13–16; Eph 4:11–16; 1 Cor 9:27.
- Ask questions – Acts 8:30–31; Matt 16:13–20; Mark 11:27–33; Rom 2:3–4.
- Connect with your audience without compromising your convictions – 1 Cor 9:19–23; Acts 17:22–31; John 3:1–21; 4:7–26; Prov 15:28; 1 Pet 3:15.
- Start with a point of interest (e.g., family, church, worship, Bible) and then take people where they need to go from there – e.g., Jesus, Philip, Paul.
- *Application*: Pray specifically for those whom you want to teach, watch for opportunities, and then speak (invite) with love and tact – Col 4:2–6.

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
