KNOW THY ENEMY

- Who is Satan? (Rev 12:9–10; 1 Pet 5:8)
- Where does Satan come from? (Ps 148:2, 5; Jude 6, 8–9; 2 Pet 2:4; Eph 6:12; Rev 12:4, 7, 13, 17)
- What does Satan do? (Rev 13:1–18; Dan 10:10–21)
- What should we do? (Jas 4:7–10; Eph 6:10–18; 1 Pet 5:8–9; Gal 6:1–2; Matt 4:1–11)



The enemy will lose (Matt 25:41)!
