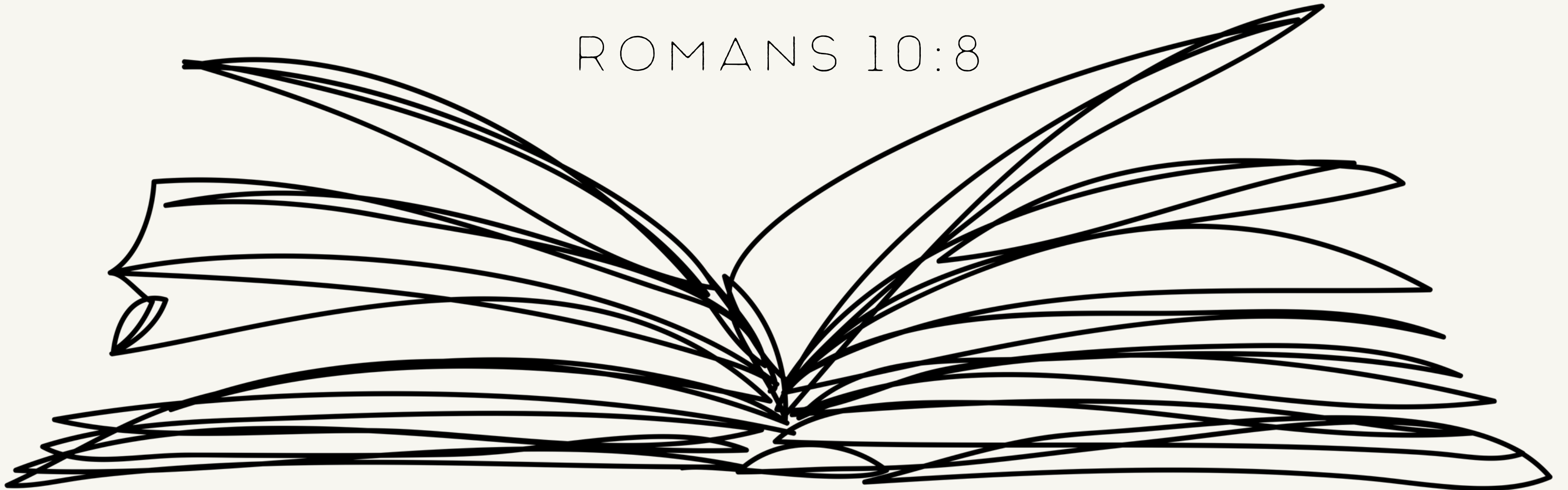

# A CASE NOT AN EQUATION

- Satan made a case based on surface interpretation (Matt. 4:6; Psa. 91:11-12).
- We crave simplicity and precision (Matt. 19:16-21).
- The Hebrew writer builds a very complex case (Heb. 8:1).
- A verse is a piece of evidence but it is never all of the evidence (Psa. 22:9-10; 51:5).
- I can prove some things without proving everything (2 Tim. 3:7; 1 Tim. 6:3-5).



# WORDS MEAN THINGS

- Don't assume total precision (Eph. 2:8; Jn. 8:58; Gal. 1:4-5; Heb. 1:2; 1 Jn. 2:15).
- Be careful of word roots (1 Cor. 1:23; Psa. 51:1-2).
- Don't apply modern ideas to ancient words (Rom. 1:16; 8:15; Matt. 19:9).
