VISION & LEGACY

- Reminders are a constant throughout the Old Testament (Ex. 24:4; Josh. 22:26-34; 1 Sam. 7:12).
- Their abuse does not disprove their value (2 Kgs. 18:4).
- This was about instructing future generations (Josh. 4:21-23; Ex. 12:26-27).



CREATING COMMUNITY

- This is more than participation, it is identity (Ex. 24:4).
- This reflected what should have happened in each household (Josh. 4:21-23; Ex. 19:6).
- We need to work toward the ideal picture (Acts 2:46; Jn. 17:21).



CULTURAL IMPACT

- “That all the people may know” (Josh. 4:24–5:1).
- This is true for both positive and negative perceptions (Acts 2:47; 5:11–13).
- We aren’t just polite versions of worldly people (Rom. 12:2; Acts 17:6; Matt. 7:26).
