If We Pay Attention, We're Enticed

When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained . . . (Psalm 8:3)

THE WORKS THAT GOD HAS DONE CAN HAVE A GREAT IMPACT UPON US IF WE PAY ATTENTION TO THEM. Whether we consider God's works as those of *creation* (His world) or of *revelation* (His word), both can affect us powerfully, pulling us into a more reverent and grateful response to Him. Yet neither nature nor the Scriptures are powerful enough to impress us if we are unobservant. For the significance of what we see and hear to sink in and alter our character and conduct, we have to pay attention.

Senses. If all five of our physical senses are working normally, we should consider that a great gift. The ability to see, hear, taste, touch, and smell is a marvelous ability. Philosophers have long debated how much of our knowledge comes from sensory experience, but few would deny that our knowledge is linked to our senses in some important way. Our senses are our connection to the greater reality that surrounds us. But as wonderful an endowment as they are, our senses do us little good if we don't use them. *Continued on the next page.....*
