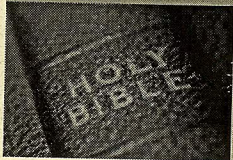

The Golden Rule

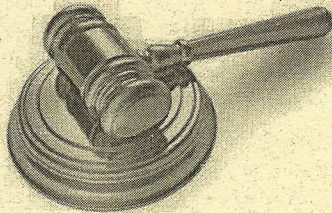
Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do you even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets. Matt. 7:12
