A plea offered in extenuation of a fault or irregular department; apology.

Every man has an excuse to offer for his neglect of duty.

The debtor makes excuses for delay of payment.

“But suppose they will not believe me or listen to my voice...”

‘hen’ – if

To lay down or state as a proposition or fact that may exist or be true, though not known or believed to be true or to exist; or to imagine or admit to exist, for the sake of argument or illustration

Show them signs – prove it.

“...I am not eloquent...I am slow of speech and slow of tongue.”

I do not speak well

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Do you use these excuses?
