## Godhead

‘theiotes’ – divinity, Godhead

‘theios’ – godlike (divinity); spoken of the only and true God, trinity

‘theos’ - a deity, especially the supreme Divinity; the Godhead, trinity

Acts 17 : 29

“...of the Divine Nature...” (Godhead – KJV)

Romans 1 : 20

“...His eternal power and Godhead...” (divinity – ASV)

Colossians 2 : 9

“...the Godhead bodily.”

Matthew 28 : 18 – 20

The Father

The Son

The Holy Spirit

How do we know each are God?

Titus 1 : 4

God the Father

John 1 : 1, 14, 18

The Son (the Word) is God

Acts 5 : 3 – 4

The Holy Spirit is God

# The Godhead Three

How do we relate this – how are Three One?

Government of the United States

Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches

However, this isn't truly the best analogy

Water

What is its chemical composition? H<sub>2</sub>O

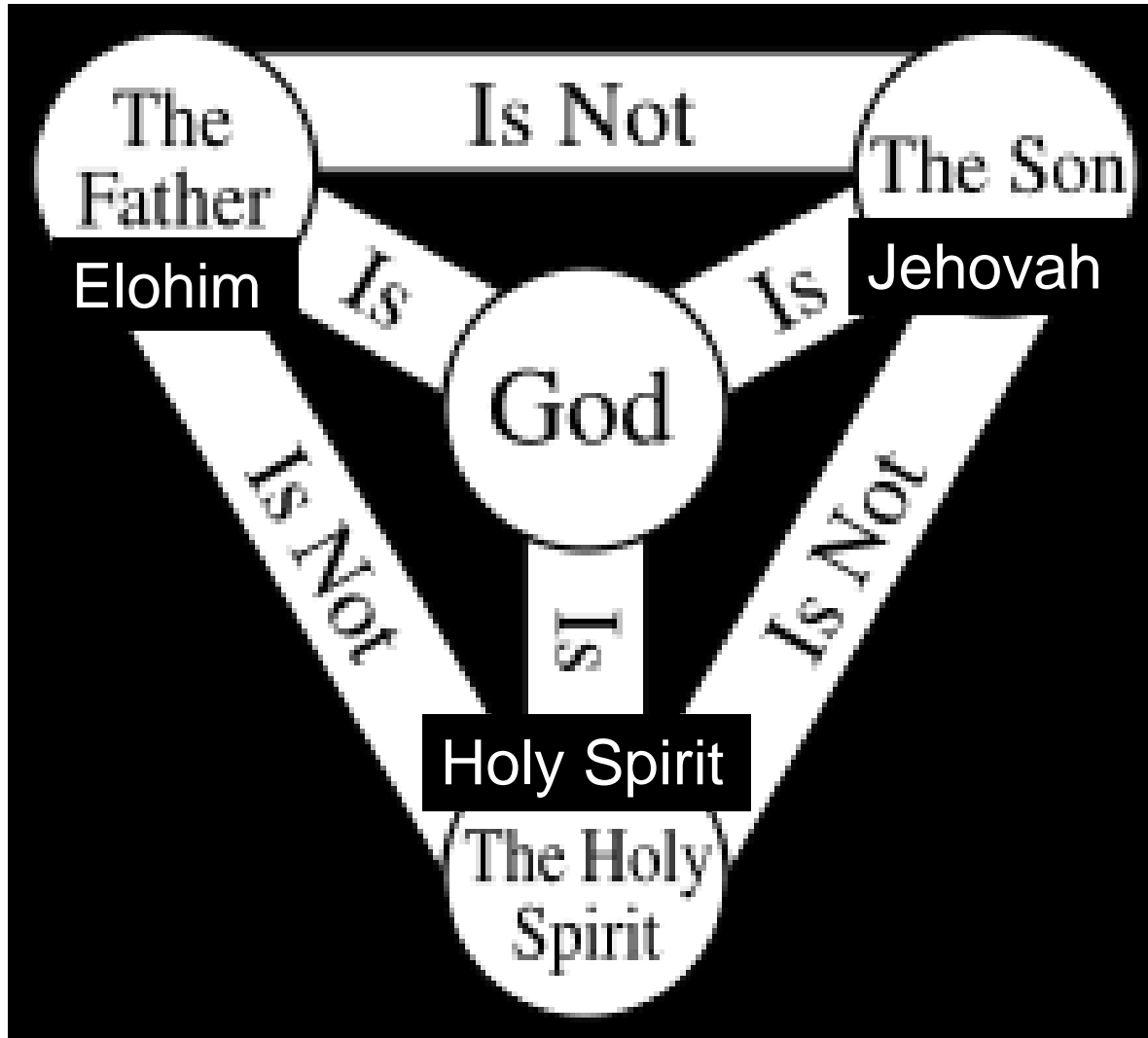
Solid, Liquid or Gas States

Like God; H<sub>2</sub>O is always H<sub>2</sub>O no matter what state it is

The Father is God, The Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God

The Father is God

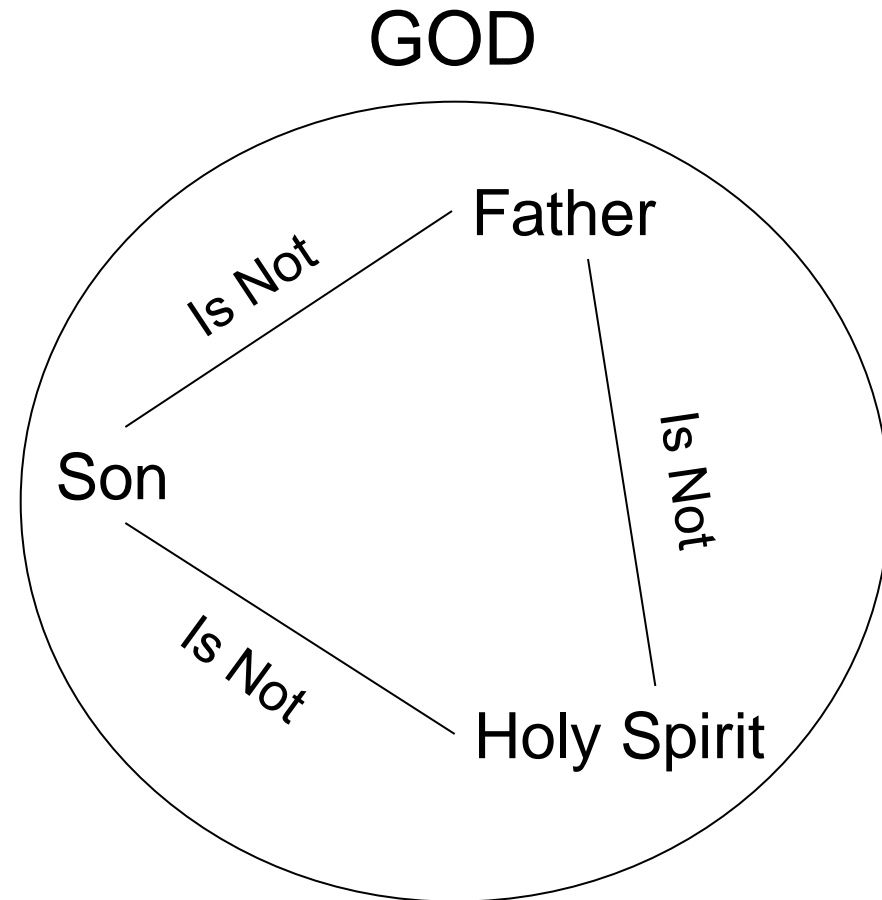
The Son is God

The Holy Spirit is God

The Father is not the Son

The Son is not the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is not the Father



The same holds true about each state of Water (H<sub>2</sub>O)

Ice (Solid) is not Steam (Gas), Steam (Gas) is not Water (Liquid), Water (Liquid) is not Ice (Solid)

# The Godhead Three

How do we relate this – what roles does Each have?

Architect, Contractor, Interior Decorator

Architect – Has the plan, develops and designs it

Contractor – Follows the plan, constructs what is designed

Interior Decorator – Finished out the finished product

Ephesians 1 : 3 – 12

“...He chose us...”

# The Godhead Three

How do we relate this – what roles does each have?

Architect, Contractor, Interior Decorator

Contractor – Follows the plan, constructs what is designed

God the Son the Contractor

John 1 : 3; Colossians 1 : 16 – 17

Nothing was made without Him; all was made for Him

John 4 : 34; 6 : 38 – 40

Jesus did the will of His Father; He built what He designed

Matthew 16 : 17 – 19

Jesus built the Church, the Kingdom that the Father designed



# The Godhead Three

How do we relate this – what roles does each have?

Architect, Contractor, Interior Decorator

Interior Decorator – Finished out the finished product

God the Holy Spirit the Decorator
