All of the figures on this chart are derived from Genesis 5.

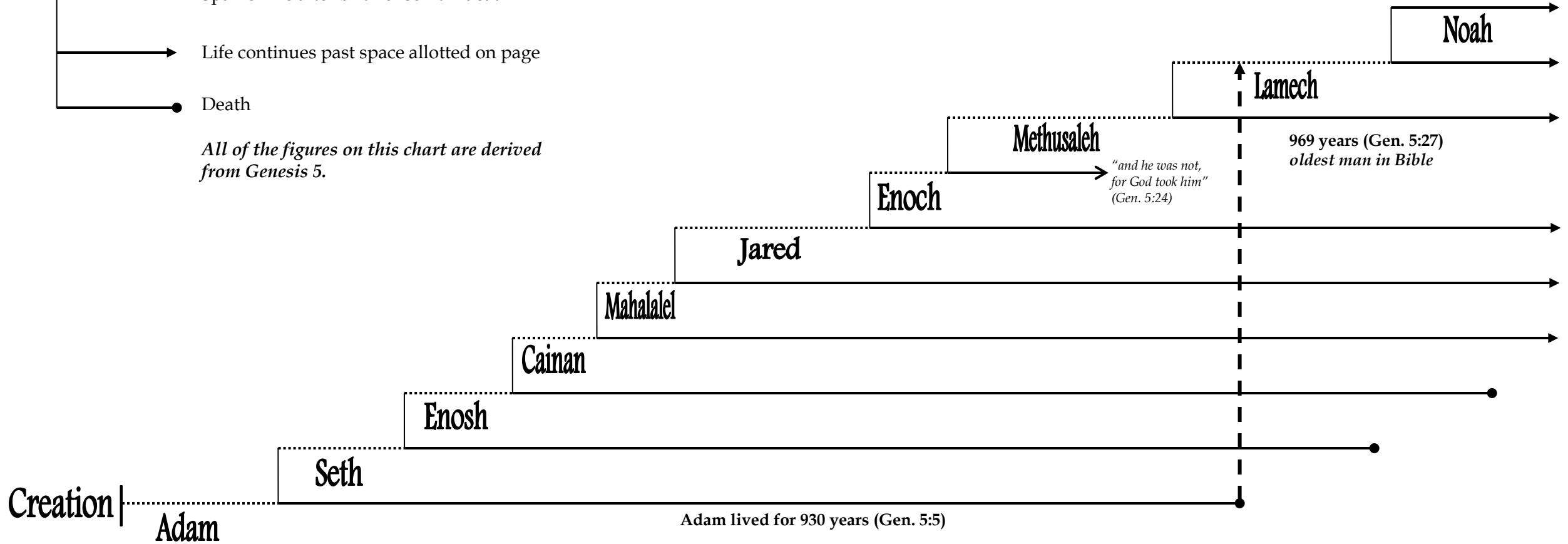

Even though we see 10 generations represented here, there was so much overlap because these men lived for 900 years on average. Imagine your great-great-great-great-great-great grandfather being alive, a man with over 900 years of life experiences. That would be like having someone today whose life spanned back to the days of the Crusades. What this indicates is that the stories of Genesis 1-3 (Creation, the Garden of Eden and the temptation and fall of man) would have been easily preserved from the days of Adam to the days of Noah. As this chart illustrates, Adam was still alive during the days of Noah's father, Lamech!
