

## The Extent To Which Jesus Foretold His Coming Death & Resurrection

1. **John 2:18-21** — *“Destroy this temple (His body), and in three days I will raise it up.”*
2. **John 3:14-15** — *“As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up.”*
3. **John 8:28** — *“When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then shall you know that I am He.”*
4. **John 12:32-33** — *“By this (His reference to being “lifted up”) He signified by what manner of death He would die.”*
5. **Mark 10:38** — *“Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, and to be baptized with the baptism I am baptized with?” “Cup” and “baptism” referring to His coming death.*
6. **Luke 12:50** — *“I have a baptism to be baptized with.”* Referring again to His coming death.
7. **John 18:11** — *“The cup which the Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?”*

**The foregoing were all in metaphorical language. In the following He uses plain language.**

8. **Matthew 16:21** — He declares *“from that time”* that He must go to Jerusalem, suffer many things of the elders, chief priests and scribes, be killed, and the third day be raised up. Parallel passages are Mark 8:31 and Luke 9:22.
9. **Matthew 17:9** — *“Tell the vision (the transfiguration) to no man, until the Son of Man be risen from the dead.”* Mark 9:9 is parallel.
10. **Matthew 17:12-13** — *“Even so shall the Son of Man also suffer of them.”* As did John the Baptist.
11. **Matthew 17:22- 23** — *“The Son of Man shall be delivered up into the hands of men; and they shall kill Him, and the third day He shall be raised up.”* Mark 9:31 and Luke 9:44 are parallel (Luke mentions only the betrayal).
12. **Matthew 20:17-19** — *“Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man shall be delivered unto the chief priests and scribes; and they shall condemn Him to death, and shall deliver Him unto the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify; and the third day He shall be raised up.”* Mark 10:32-34 and Luke 18:31-34 are parallel, but they reveal a little more.
13. **Matthew 21 :37-39** — Jesus is the son in the parable of the wicked husbandmen who was killed by them. Mark 12:6-8 and Luke 20:13-15 are parallel.
14. **Matthew 26: 1-2** — *“You know that after two days the passover cometh, and the Son of Man is delivered up to be crucified.”*

**Their failure to understand even the plain statements is pointed out in Mark 9:32; Luke 9:45 and Luke 18:34. Believers know that these were all prophecies or predictions made by Jesus that were all fulfilled.**
