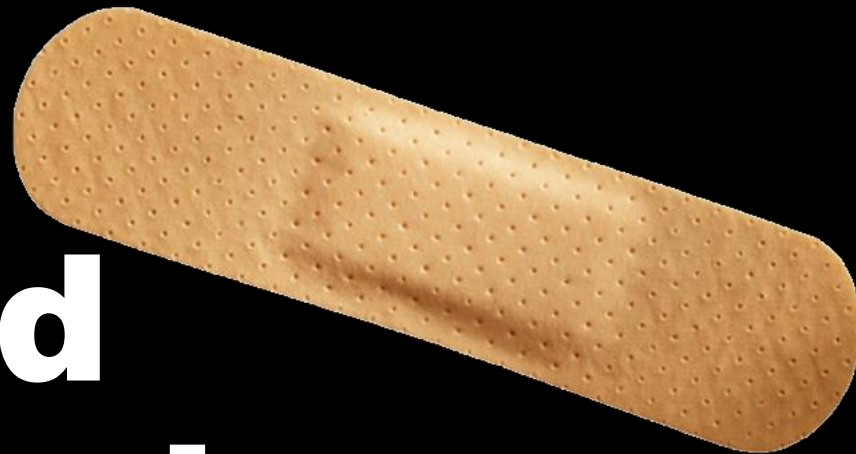

“If our hearts are turned toward God, then pure regret can be a gentle reminder of our continuing need for His grace. It can be a part of the hunger that brings us to Him.”

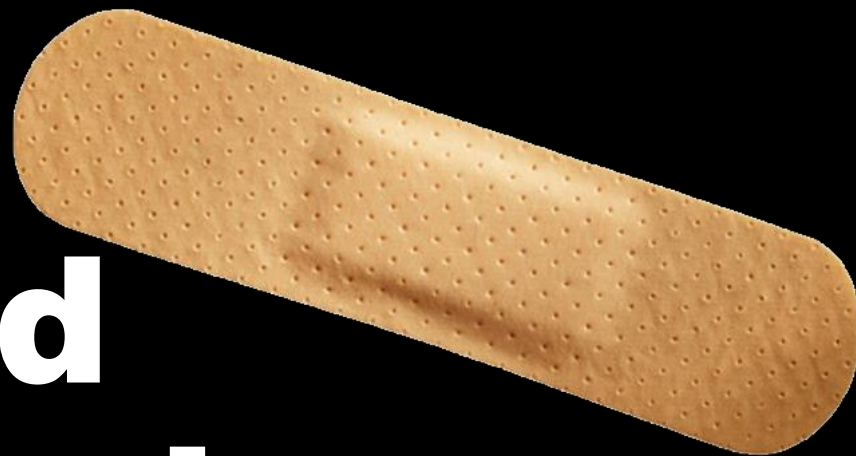
