- v 21 – Benjamin's Failure at Jerusalem
- vv 22-26 – Joseph Conquers Bethel

Failure to Complete the Conquest

- vv 27-28 – Manasseh did not drive out...
- v 29 – Ephraim did not drive out...
- v 30 – Zebulun did not drive out...
- vv 31-32 – Asher did not drive out...
- v 33 – Naphtali did not drive out...
- v 34 – The Amorites pressed the people of Dan
- vv 35-36 – The Amorites Persisted



Judges 2

- vv 1-3 – The Lord's Rebuke
- vv 4-5 – The People's Response
- vv 6-9 – Joshua and Generation Die
- v 10 – A New Generation






Judges 2

The Judges Cycle

- vv 11-13 – The People Sin
- vv 14-15 – The Lord Punishes the People
- vv 16-18 – The Lord Raises Judges
- v 19 – The People Sin



Judges 2:20—3:6

The Canaanites Remain

- 2:20-23 – God’s Response to Israel’s Failures
- 3:1-2 – “that Israel might know war”
- 3:3-5 – The Remaining Nations
- 3:6 – Assimilation
