INTRO:

1. NOTE... ..Last week we studied the relationship of marriage. The husband is the ‘head’ (guardian, protector, manager, superintendent and one responsible for the direction of the family).

2. The wife is the “helper” (aid, suitable counterpart) **Gen. 2:18** The woman was made for the man. **1 Cor. 11:8-9**

I. WHAT WE ARE AS INDIVIDUALS, WE BRING TO THE MARRIAGE... ..COMMENT

1. God has revealed his will for marriage when we both (husband and wife) follow this will and plan. Only then will we be truly happy. Anything less than this breeds unhappiness.

2. Marriages that follow God's plan can be a little bit of paradise left to bless both husband and wife.

3. Finally, here are some helpful pointers:

a. Have a happy disposition.

Remember we are supposed to be in this relationship for life. **Prov. 15:13, 17:22, 16:24**

b. Be sure the solution of differences is best for both parties. **Prov. 15:28-31**

c. Be filled with humility. **Prov. 15:33**

d. Forgive and forget. **Jas. 5:16; 1 Cor. 13:5; Eph. 4:32**

e. Never make demands or ultimatums.

f. TRY, TRY, TRY to get along.
