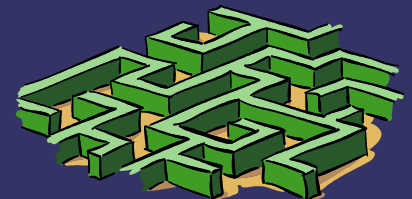


# *Jesus asks questions*

We can learn from Jesus' questions

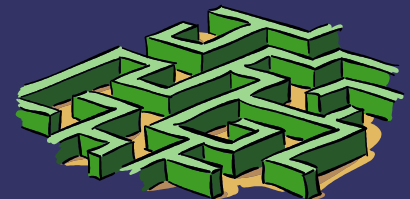


## ***2<sup>nd</sup> Command – Love neighbor***

If you greet only your brothers, what are you doing more than others? (Matthew 5:47)

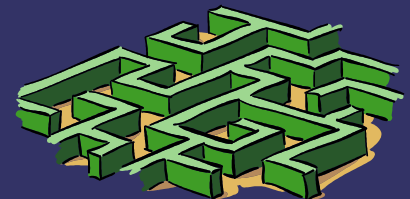
1Co 16:20 All the brethren greet you. Greet one another with holy kiss.

Heb 13:2 show love, hospitable to strangers

3Jo 1:5 obligation to both

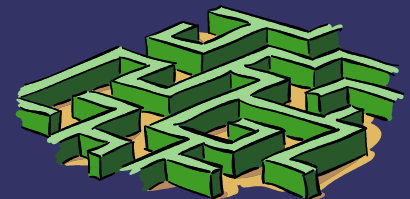
Spiritual myopia is treatable. Mat 13:15 just like Jesus healed the blind, but is there an eye test for it? Mat 7:5

Heb 4:12 God's word is not dull



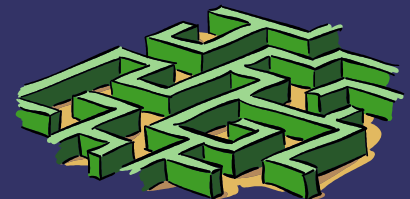
# *Time to grow*

God's providence to others?



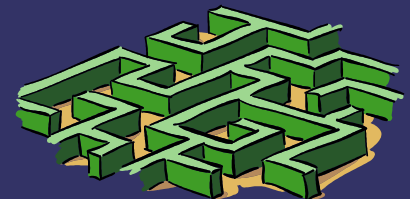
# *Kinfolk*

How do you treat your own mother?

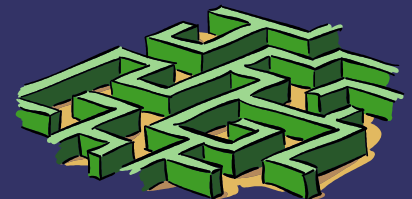
Do we go out of our way to help our family?

# *Each generation is to be called*

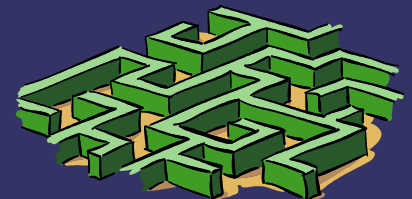
To what can I compare this generation?

# *Who are we up against?*

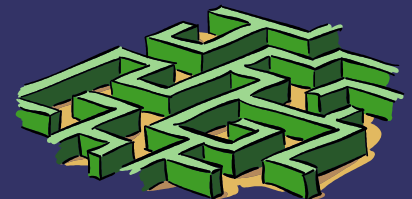
