From Sorrow to Sin

Sin is not relief, it is the beginning (Gen. 2:16, 17; 3:1-6, 16-19).

Sin is not relief, it is the continuation (Prov. 23:29, 30).

David begot much sorrow from sin (2 Sam. 12:13-19; 18:33-19:8).

Sorrow will lead us down paths of darkness and destruction (Matt. 27:3-5).

Sin and Sorrow will bring death (2 Cor. 7:10; Rom. 6:23).

From Sorrow to God

The end of sorrow begins with God (2 Cor. 7:10; Rom. 6:23).

The right sorrow produces the right actions and reactions (2 Sam. 12:19-24 Acts 2:37-42).

God will relieve us of our sorrows (Phil. 4:6, 7; Rev. 21:1-4).

Our sorrows were part of Jesus' burden (Isa. 53:4-6).

Relieved of our sorrows, we are given a means to stand (Mic. 6:6-8; 7:8).
