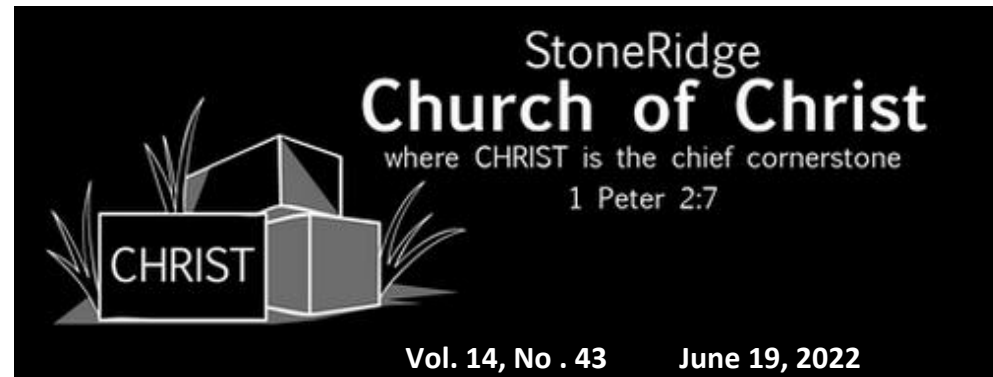

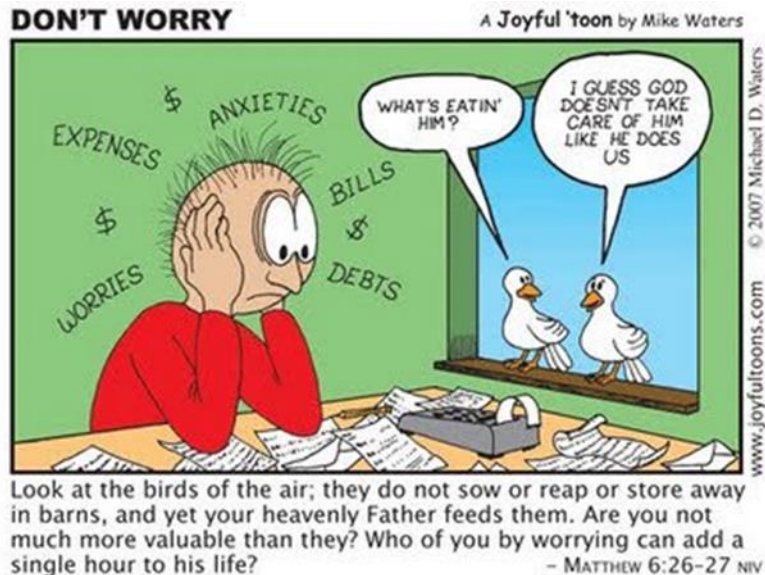
Isaiah 40:15, 17, and 23:
