“To set the heart upon, long for, covet.”

“A longing, especially for what is forbidden; deeds of greed, fraudulence, extortion.”

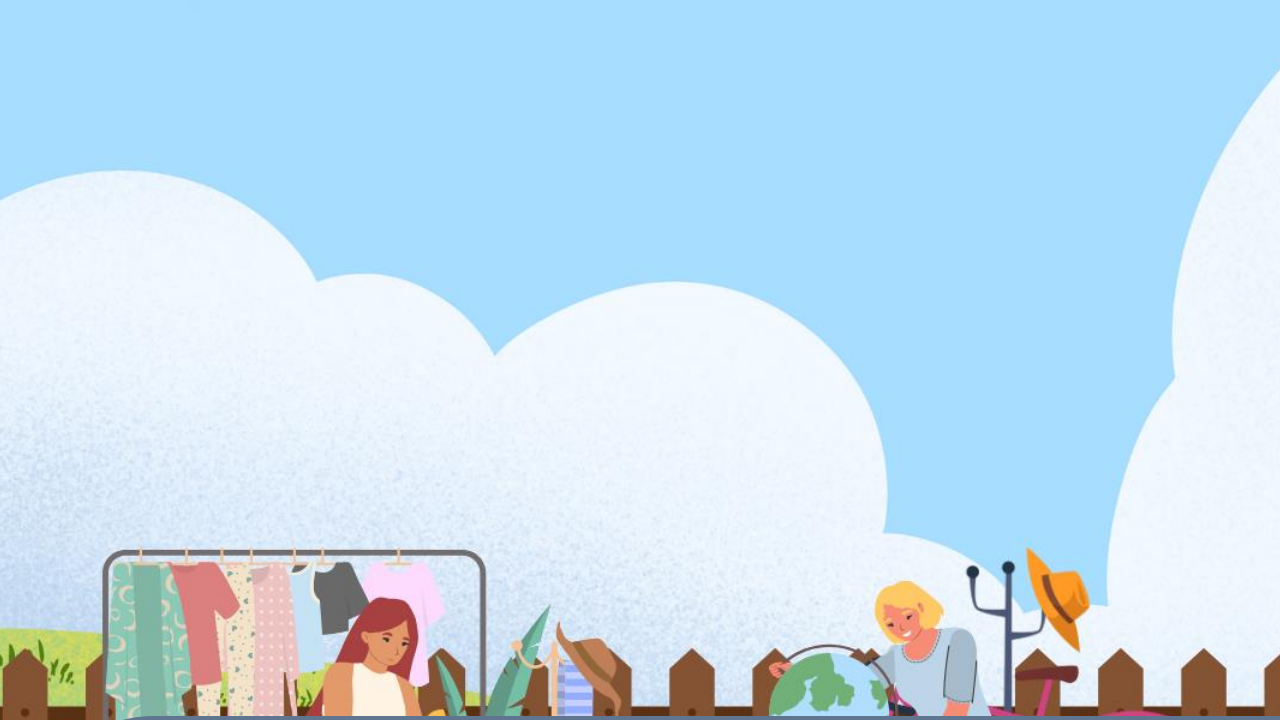
