Great Themes in Daniel & the Prophets

- I. The Sovereignty of God – God governs the world and all nations in it (1:2; 4:34-37; 5:25-31)
- II. The Holiness and Grandeur of God – Absolutely pure and great beyond words (7:9-14)
- III. The Immutability of God’s Word – God fulfills His word. He can always be depended on. (2:36-40; 4:24-27; 5:25-31; II Chron. 36:21; Ezra 1:1)
- IV. Unrepentant Sin will not go Unpunished – God is very patient but He will punish the unrepentant. God is just and merciful. (1:1 cp. Df. 28:1 ff; 5:25-31)
- V. God Can Use Any Means He Chooses to Accomplish His Purpose Including a Wicked Nation (1:1; Hab. 1:13)
- VI. Sometimes the Righteous Must Suffer with the Wicked (1:3; Hab. 3:16-19; Hab. 2:4)
- VII. God Chastens Those Whom He Loves to Lead Them to Repentance (Ezra 1-3; Amos 4:6-12)
- VIII. It is Foolish to Trust in Prosperity or Physical Strength (Amos 6:1 “woe to those at ease ...”)
- IX. No Matter what Happens in this World we Must Learn to Trust the Lord (Dan. 1:8; 3:28; 6:10; Hab. 2:4)
- X. God has not Forgotten His People – He continues to care and provide for them (1:9,17; 2:19; 3:25)
