# Mark 9:14-32

1. What was the reason for the dispute between the scribes and Jesus' apostles?
  - The disciples had been unable to cast a demon out of a boy (Mk9:16-18)

# Mark 9:14-32

2. What did Jesus say was the reason the apostles could not cast out the demon? What does this mean?

“So He said to them, ‘This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting.’” (Mk 9:29, NKJV)

# Mark 9:33-50

3. What were the disciples arguing about on the road to Capernaum?

“But they kept silent , for on the road they had disputed among themselves who would be the greatest.” (Mk 9:34, NKJV)

# Mark 9:33-50

4. How did Jesus respond when His disciples told Him there were others casting out demons in His name?

“But Jesus said, ‘Do not forbid him, for no one who works a miracle in My name can soon afterward speak evil of Me. For he who is not against us is on our side.’” (Mk 9:39-40, NKJV)

# Mark 9:33-50

5. What is Jesus' point in His illustrations about sin and hell?
  - Remove any hinderance that will lead you into sin

# Mark 10:1-12

6. What question does the Pharisees ask in Mark 10:2? Why did they ask Jesus this?
  - “The Pharisees came and asked Him, ‘Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?’ testing Him.” (Mk 10:2, NKJV)

# Mark 10:1-12

7. Why did Moses allow for the men of Israel to divorce their wives? What restrictions were placed upon this?

“And Jesus answered and said to them, ‘Because of the hardness of your heart he wrote you this precept.’” (Mk 10:5, NKJV)



# Mark 10:1-12

7. Why did Moses allow for the men of Israel to divorce their wives? What restrictions were placed upon this?
- Divorce should be related to some uncleanness in the wife (Deut 24:1)
  - A certificate of divorce must be given (Deut 24:1)
  - The husband could not take her back if she married another man (Deut 24:2-4)

# Mark 10:1-12

## 8. What is Jesus' point in Mark 10:6-12?

- God instituted marriage in the garden, and questions about it should be answered by God, not man or man's laws
- The permanency of marriage was God's design from the beginning
- Divorce is a violation of God's will
- Divorce and remarriage for any reason other than sexual immorality results in adultery (cf. Matt 19:9)

# Mark 10:17-31

9. What is the rich young ruler seeking? Why does he leave Jesus sorrowful?
- “...’Good teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?’” (Mk 10:17, NKJV)
  - He was very rich (Mk 10:22)

# Mark 10:17-31

10. What promise does Jesus give in Mark 10:29-30? What does this mean?
- The sacrifices made by a disciple of Christ will be rewarded, both now and in the age to come
