Mark 10:32-11:26

Mark 10:17-31

9. What is the rich young ruler seeking? Why does he leave Jesus sorrowful?
 - “...’Good teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?’” (Mk 10:17, NKJV)
 - He was very rich (Mk 10:22)

10. What promise does Jesus give in Mark 10:29-30? What does this mean?
- The sacrifices made by a disciple of Christ will be rewarded, both now and in the age to come

Mark 10:32-45

1. What does James and John ask to receive from Jesus? What does this question reveal about their understanding of the teachings of Jesus thus far?

“They said to Him, ‘Grant us that we may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on Your left, in Your glory.’” (Mk 10:37, NKVJ)

2. What is Jesus' purpose according to Mark 10:45? Taking other passages into consideration, is this a good summary of His purpose?

“For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but **to serve**, and **to give His life a ransom for many.**”

(Mk 10:45, NKVJ)

Mark 11:1-11

3. What did Jesus want His disciples to do as they approached Jerusalem? What Old Testament prophecy does this event fulfill?
- Go into the opposite village
 - Find an unbroken colt and bring it to Him
 - Tell those who ask that the Lord has need of the colt
 - Zech 9:9

Mark 11:12-14

4. What event occurs the next day on the road from Bethany to Jerusalem?
 - Jesus cursed the fig tree for not having edible fruit

Mark 11:12-14

5. What lessons did Jesus teach His apostles by cursing the fig tree?
 - This was a judgment against hypocrisy
 - Those who have an appearance of righteousness from afar but are unproductive will be receive God's wrath

Mark 11:15-19

6. Why did Jesus drive the money changers out of the temple?

“Then He taught, saying to them, ‘Is it not written, ‘My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations’? But you have made it a ‘den of thieves.’”
(Mk 11:17, NKJV)

Mark 11:15-19

7. How did the scribes and chief priests respond to Jesus' actions in the temple?
 - They sought a way to kill Him (Mk 11:18)
 - They questioned His authority to do this (Mk 11:27-28)

8. Summarize what Jesus teaches about forgiveness.
 - One must be forgive towards others to receive forgiveness from the Father
 - Withholding forgiveness can hinder our growth in faith and our access to the Father through prayer
