- *600<sup>th</sup> year, 2<sup>nd</sup> month, 17<sup>th</sup> day flood began*

**Genesis 7:17:** *Flood came upon earth for 40 days*

**Genesis 7:24:** *Water prevailed upon the earth 150 days.*

**Genesis 8:3-4:** *Water receded steadily from the earth at the end of the 150 days the water decreased*

- *7<sup>th</sup> month, 17<sup>th</sup> day, ark rested upon mountains of Ararat*

**Genesis 8:6:** *End of 40 days Noah opened up window of Ark*

*Genesis 8:13:*

- *601<sup>st</sup> year*
- *1<sup>st</sup> month*
- *Water was dried up*

- *27<sup>th</sup> day the earth was dry*
- *God spoke and told Noah and family to get out of the Ark.*
