

Lesson 23- Foot washers

John 13:3-17

3 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God, 4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. 5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. 6 Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, "Lord, are You washing my feet?"

7 Jesus answered and said to him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this."

8 Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me."



Lesson 23- Foot washers

John 13:3-17

9 Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!"

10 Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you." 11 For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "You are not all clean."

12 So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? 13 You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. 14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. 15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. 16 Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. 17 If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them. NKJV



Lesson 23- Foot washers

Phil 2:5-8:

5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. NKJV



Lesson 23- Foot washers

Matt 20:25-28

25 But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. 26 Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. 27 And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave — 28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many." NKJV



Lesson 23- Foot washers

1 Peter 5:2-3

2 Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; 3 nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock; NKJV



Lesson 24- Give it Up for God!

John 10:11-14

11 "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. 12 But a hireling, he who is not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them. 13 The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep. 14 I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. NKJV

To receive power and riches and wisdom,



Lesson 24- Give it Up for God!



1. Abraham. *What did he give up for God that we read about in Acts 7:2-5, Hebrews 1:8-16, Genesis 12:1-5 and 17:4?*

- Gave up his homeland. Also was willing to give up his son.

2. Moses. *What did he sacrifice for God and what was the result? (Hebrews 11:23-29 and Acts 7:35-36)*

- Gave up treasures of Egypt, passing pleasures of sin; Became leader of God's people. Inheritance.

3. The Apostles. *What did they give up and what resulted? (Matt 19:27-28, II Cor. 5:20)*

- "Left all" but gained much more....became Christ's ambassadors.

4. Saul of Tarsus-the Apostle Paul. *What did He give up and what resulted? (Phil 3:4-8)*

- Gave up what his Jewish heritage afforded him. But he gained Christ!

Lesson 24- Give it Up for God!

Luke 15:3-6

3 So He spoke this parable to them, saying:

4 "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? 5 And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. 6 And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!' NKJV

Acts 20:31

31 Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears. NKJV
