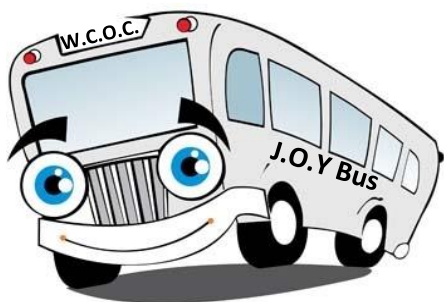

We Have the Cure!

Amidst all of the talk about COVID19 these last few months, one of the recurring conversations is when we will have a vaccine. Until then, we are only going to slow or limit the spread of the virus. Although it has sounded promising, nothing has happened yet.

Every year it seems, we have a friend or family member with a cancer diagnosis. I don't know what previous generations' experience was with cancer, but it sure seems like we see it more frequently today than in the past.
