## Who's in Charge?

This morning's lesson is about authority...kind of. In Mark 11:27-33, Jesus answers a question from the religious leaders with another question, painting them into a corner on how to answer him. They walk away, unable to answer.

Although not the direct point of the passage, this passage has made me think this week—who's in charge of your life? Of course, as Christians, we claim God is in charge of our lives, but if we're honest we let a lot of other things occupy that seat: our anger, our desires to be loved, our family ties, our political inclinations. What if God was truly in charge of your life? What would you do differently? How could you clear out all the other "stuff" that sways our opinions or emotions in decision making, and truly act out of obedience to God? When God is in charge, our decisions don't always make sense to others, they don't always make for easy living, and they certainly require us to always be evaluating our motives and desires.

It is healthy from time to time to "take stock" of our decisions, both present and past, and see if they align with what pleases God. Only when we are honest with ourselves and the things we have chosen in the past will we be able to understand if God is truly in charge. So...who's in charge?
