Scott will be on vacation Saturday July 23rd through Saturday July 30th. Keith will be on vacation Sunday July 24th through Saturday July 30th.

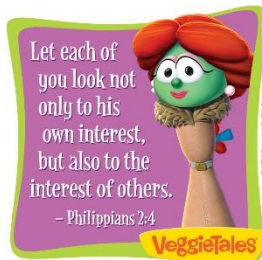


Teen Girl Camping Trip

I'm not sure if I care for either. My grandfather played the banjo, but I'm pretty sure I don't have that gift and I don't know anyone in our family that played the harp. We all have our preferences though, don't we? One person likes harps, another likes banjos. One person likes musicals, another likes action movies. We're familiar with preferences in everyday life, but what about preferences in the church? What's the difficulty with preferences in the church? We have to endure everyone else's! I'm sure you've seen people get upset about a lot of things that happen in church. Most of the time, it has nothing to do with core doctrinal beliefs. It's the color for the new carpet, whether we should move the furniture in the lobby, the design of the new bathrooms, having a contemporary or traditional worship, serving communion before or after the sermon, when to do announcements, who we like leading worship, which preacher we prefer, etc. The list goes on and on and on.

Preferences are not bad, so long as we remember to keep the main thing the main thing. Never allow a preference to become a point of division and never allow preference to take precedence over the mission.
