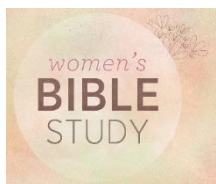

Real Faith

The other day, one of my sergeants sent me a link to a video from his church. He is a youth minister outside of the National Guard and has been teaching a Bible class at his church on Hebrews. The video he shared was the class on Hebrews 11, which we often refer to as the “Hall of Faith” chapter. In the class, my sergeant did a great job telling the story of Abraham and relating it to everyday life. He and I often share what we are doing at our churches; he has been a great encouragement to me as we share Christ with the men in our unit.

As I finished watching the video, a thought occurred to me. How many times have we read the stories of faith in Hebrews 11, not realizing that these men and women had flaws too? We read about their shining moments, not the ones where they acted like real people and made mistakes. This thought prompted the next 3-week series entitled “Real Faith” where we will look at three characters from Hebrews 11 and examine both sides of their life: their shining moments and their not-so-shining moments. As we do so, I hope you’ll see that these people were just like you and I, and that faith is sometimes messy. People can be incredible examples to follow in one moment, and in the next moment demonstrate something to avoid. This is real life. WHAT IS WALK4WATER?

Globally, the average distance to walk for water is four miles, if there is even any water to be found. This pattern is not sustainable and stunts the growth of families and individuals everywhere. This is why we Walk4Water. Walk4Water is a fundraising program within Healing Hands International that helps support its Clean Water program. Starting in 2007, Walk4Water has hosted events in communities all over the nation at schools, churches, and organizations. The goal is to bring the life-saving gift of clean water to those who need it so desperately. Since 2001, we are grateful to share over 1,500 clean water wells have been drilled in over ten countries. The impact is exponential — clean water leads to abundant life!
