

24 HOURS BEFORE THE CROSS: A TIMELINE



MARK 14-15

JOHN 13-19

MATTHEW 26-27

LUKE 22-23

THURSDAY -- 6:00 PM TO 9:00 PM

Jesus washes the disciples' feet
They share the Passover meal together

THURSDAY -- 9:00 PM

Judas leaves group to make his arrangements with High Priest
Jesus and the rest begin the walk to the Garden

THURSDAY -- 11:00 PM

Jesus is arrested and taken to the home of Annas

FRIDAY -- 12:00 AM TO 6:00 AM

Jesus is taken to Caiaphas and the Sanhedrin
Peter denies his connection to him three times
Judas attempts to return the money before committing suicide
Jesus is handed over to Pilate
The Jewish hierarchy is joined by a mob of Jews
Pilate invites Herod to interrogate Jesus

FRIDAY -- 6:00 AM

Pilate is pressured to release Barabbas and sentences Jesus to crucifixion
After further physical abuse the walk to Golgotha begins

FRIDAY -- 9:00 AM

He is nailed to a large wooden cross and placed between two thieves
His clothes are removed and divided
Passersby continue to glare and mock
His mother and John have made their way to the cross

FRIDAY -- 12:00 PM TO 3:00 PM

The sun goes dark and for three hours the land is as dark as night

FRIDAY -- 3:00 PM

After uttering "It is finished", Jesus died
